Attendance

We have recently had a visit from the attendance officer who is very pleased with the overall attendance of our school – currently 97% ...our target is 97.5%

Any child's attendance that falls **below 90%** is considered to be a persistent absent child. **You will receive a letter if your child falls into this category,** even if we know the reasons for your absence. We have a legal responsibility to follow up absence from school. It is essential that all children's attendance is at least 95%. There will be a **'late gate'** by the Attendance officer several times in the coming weeks so please ensure that all children arrive on time.
