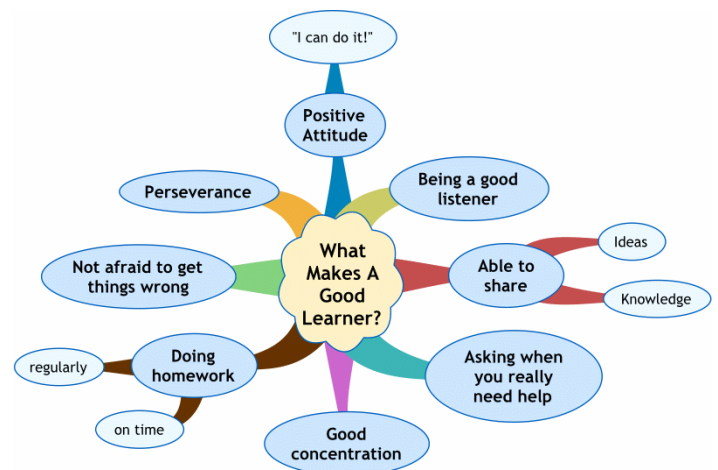
School Reports
